
We need your support to help Acorn grow

Our mission:

To assist people with a disability or long-term health condition find and maintain employment.

£25,000

pays for one support worker to be employed for a year, enabling 15 more people who have a disability or long-term health condition to access training and development at Acorn.

£3,650

allows an upcycling project to run for six months. Projects offer valuable training and development opportunities for up to eight people at a time. Our clients upcycle wood, jewellery and furniture for reselling at Acorn. The cost covers a tutor, materials and support staff.

£5,000

pays for a person with a disability or long-term health condition to be employed as a retail assistant for three months. Our retail assistants are key to the day-to-day operation of the Acorn Reuse Centre.

£2,000

pays for an electronic workbench, making the workplace fully inclusive. It allows work to be carried out at different heights according to what project is being undertaken or to suit the client's needs. An electronic workbench can be operated by all independently.

In the first year of Reuse:



50 paid jobs created



410
training opportunities provided to 168 clients



10 other charities benefiting from Reuse



585 tonnes of waste removed from the waste stream

£1,850

pays for our allotment project to run for 12 weeks. Sixteen people currently enjoy looking after our allotment, which has proved particularly beneficial for those who have mental health issues. We sell some produce at Acorn on an 'honesty box' basis.

£1.400

pays for a person with a disability or long-term health condition to be employed as a reuse assistant for one month. The more popular we become, the more we need reuse assistants to help with the collection, sorting and pricing of stock.

£370

pays for a manual workbench. These are needed in all areas, including Reuse, the Woodshack and upcycling and textiles projects.

£150


pays for a standing desk converter. These can raise and lower a workstation so that people can sit or stand. Standing has many health benefits, including reducing back pain and improving mood and energy levels.

£40

pays for a perching stool. Many of our staff, volunteers and clients can't stand for long periods and need a stool to enable them to do their work comfortably.
